Ops Report:

- Crime which has decreased: Robbery 41%, House Robberies – 67%.
- Crime on the increase: Minor crimes were the cause of the increase for the month.
- Very intense pro-active patrols are ongoing from the admin staff and cluster team.
- Problem days are Fridays & Saturdays between 12h00 and 00h00.
- **Priority crimes occur between 17h00 and 22h00. Please be aware of this and ensure that your perimeter doors are locked at all times and your outdoor protection is armed. The chairman asked all Sector 2 committee members to inform their residents in this regard.**
- The chairman informed the committee of the new Colonel at Honeydew SAPS who has taken over the Detective unit as head informed the CPF committee that he would be looking seriously at other crimes such as MI2P and reckless & negligent driving. He also has a firm hand on his team and requires more arrests from this unit.
- 17 Drug related arrests were made in the Honeydew Precinct for June.
- The station has currently 95 students undergoing training. The first batch of 50 will be completed in January.
- The rumours regard possible xenophobic attacks are only rumours. If however if anyone receives any positive information please e-mail the chairman on info@support-services.co.za. The SAPS have a plan in place to address this issue if it arises.
